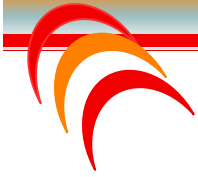
The result –

Concept - local

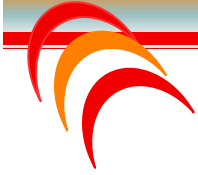
Fellowship: “*Western Australia Health Ministers Outreach Fellowship for Nurses and Midwives* “ - \$20,000

Website : repository of redundant WA medical equipment and resources to be made available to underserved populations e.g. Haiti including reference books and medical literature

Clinical placement opportunities: undergraduate nurses and midwives to enhance their experience, develop confidence

Travel bursaries: To assist nursing and midwifery experts to travel to underserved countries to up skill local workforce





Concept – international

- Assist Nurse and Midwifery leaders from underserved countries to Travel to for master classes in leadership, wound management and other fields as determined
- To support WA nursing and midwifery experts to travel to underserved countries
